How are the Operational Readiness meetings coming along?

Operational Readiness meetings continue as we prepare for the move to the Wynn Hospital. The goals of Ops Readiness are:

- Review and revise policies and procedures as they are impacted by the new facility
- Review processes and address those areas that need improvement
- Review the flow of patients and staff in the building
- Determine equipment, supply and furnishing amounts and locations
- Develop a plan for relocation of equipment
- Provide an orientation on the above
- Orientation for all of those who will be working or volunteering in the new Wynn Hospital
- Plan for the patient move.

All of these goals are set in preparation for an October 2023 move date. While many departments are well on their way, others will begin shortly.
