## TOPIC FOR TUESDAY, APRIL 19, 2022:

### *How does storage work for materials and equipment needed for the Wynn Hospital?*

Storage is important for every construction project, and while onsite storage is ideal, sometimes it isn't always feasible. This is especially true in a COVID world where items may be on backorder and then delivered all at once instead of in shifts. This happened with our roofing material in which the entire order arrived a few months late instead of being delivered in shifts as it was needed. This material was stored in the construction yard outside the future Emergency Department entrance.

Off-site storage is also needed, especially for equipment that will be used in the Wynn Hospital once it opens. For example, we are working with Kittredge Singer to store all of our major kitchen equipment in a 57,000 square foot warehouse in Enfield, Connecticut. This equipment is tagged and logged by the vendor as new items are received and will remain in the warehouse until construction is complete.
