TOPIC FOR TUESDAY, JULY 12, 2022:

Why is there an open space in the windows on the north side of the Wynn Hospital?

The windows on the top floor of the Wynn Hospital haven't been placed yet because we are still receiving deliveries of our pre-fabricated bathrooms for the Mental Health Unit, which is on the ninth floor.

This week, we will receive the final delivery of our modular bathroom units, called SurePods. SurePods are factory-built bathrooms which are sized, designed and accessorized precisely to architectural plans, then built in controlled factory conditions. Currently, all bathrooms have been delivered and put into place except for on the Mental Health Unit.

The team made several visits to Florida, where the SurePods are manufactured, to inspect and address any issues or concerns with production prior to the arrival onsite. Due to the specific anti-ligature and safety requirements for the Mental Health Unit, these bathroom units were the last to be built, delivered and installed. Once installed, the MVHS Anti-Ligature team will inspect the bathrooms along with the New York State Office of Mental Health.
