Supply Chain sessions are kicking off which will include proposed supply locations and par levels as well as a distribution plan. It's important to make sure clinical unit/departmental needs are met in a way that keeps the supply chain functioning efficiently. The same will be true for the rest of the support departments. Preparation information will be sent out to the clinical area to review before the meetings which will include a list of proposed supply inventory and par levels. All support departments will send out key information for prior review.

The goal is a consistent approach to servicing the units, but one that considers the uniqueness of the clinical area. Linen, EVS and Laboratory services will be the next departments to participate, so be on the lookout for your Ops Readiness invitations and items/information to have ready in preparation.
