MVHS Vendor Onboarding

As we move closer to the opening of the Wynn Hospital, more vendors are preparing to complete their scope of work. Just this week, Stryker, Phillips and Werfen will begin installing medical equipment in the new hospital. Coordination between MVHS, Hammes, Gilbane and the vendor at this point is crucial. Each vendor is responsible for working with Gilbane to schedule its site visit with at least 72 hours' notice. Additionally, the vendor must provide proper proof of insurance, copies of their OSHA 10 Certification and construction site agreements. All workers/installers are required to complete the Onsite Safety Orientation and a drug screening. Onsite access is not permitted if the onboarding paperwork and safety requirements are not complete/approved.

This is a lot of information to obtain and track, so a program called GoContractor is used to digitize the worker orientation and onboarding processes which helps achieve safety compliance and productivity before workers step foot on the jobsite. This program is designed to hold information such as medical, insurance, driver's license, certifications, etc. – all pertinent information that may be needed in case of an accident or injury. Once all the paperwork is completed and filed, access is granted to the vendor by Gilbane.
