Landscaping at the Wynn Hospital has begun!

Last week, the Wynn Hospital received its first delivery of trees to be planted on site. It was important to ensure a diverse mix of trees, planted in groups, similar to what you would find in a public park instead of single-species row planting. This not only gives visitors the feeling of entering a park, it also improves biodiversity and habitat creation.

The trees found in the local surrounding area today are linden trees, so that's what will be used as the most dominant species on site. The proposed perimeter trees are typically slower growing but larger species such as oak and beech, and as you get closer to the entrance, the plantings become more intricate and on a human-scale, with smaller and more colorful trees such as paper birch and American hophornbeam within the plant beds.
