Department Spotlight: All About the Children's Health Center

The MVHS Children's Health Center (CHC) offers routine health checkups and treatment for children of all ages. CHC specialists are dedicated to providing exceptional, compassionate care to the children in our community.

What does the CHC do?

The CHC sees newborns up until age 18 for their primary medical needs including wellness visits and vaccines.

Where is the CHC located?

2212 Genesee Street in Utica, across the street from the former St. Elizabeth Medical Center campus.

How many employees work at the CHC?

CHC has four providers: Teresa Martorella, MD; Cherine Awad, MD; Fadi Zakko, MD; and Onama Collins, FNP. Currently, there are three nurses and three non-clinical staff. An additional nurse and a medical assistant will be joining the practice early this year.

Dr. Awad is fluent in four languages: Arabic, French, Spanish and English.

CHC days typically consist of seeing a lot of smiling babies, toddlers and teens – but they do get their share of crying too!
