What kind of patients does the Specialty Pharmacy Department see? MVHS Specialty Pharmacy serves patients dealing with a variety of chronic and complex conditions, including:

- Cancer
- Autoimmune disorders
- HIV
- Hepatitis C
- Diabetes
- Asthma

These patients often require specialized medications that are complex and costly. The pharmacy's team collaborates closely with healthcare providers to deliver coordinated and personalized therapy experiences.

Services Offered: MVHS Specialty Pharmacy provides a comprehensive suite of services to support patients:

- **Financial Counseling:** Assistance with insurance approvals and identification of financial aid opportunities.
- **Prescription Refill Coordination:** Proactive reminders and coordination for timely refills, with options for home delivery or onsite pickup.

- Patient Consultations: Conduct counseling sessions to educate

- Administrative Tasks: Assist with prior authorization processes, coordinate with insurance companies and explore financial assistance programs for patients.
- **Team Collaboration:** Work closely with healthcare providers to optimize therapeutic regimens and address any clinical concerns.
- Follow-ups: Perform regular assessments to monitor treatment efficacy and make necessary adjustments in consultation with providers.

Through these dedicated efforts, MVHS specialty pharmacists play a crucial role in ensuring patients receive optimal care and support throughout their treatment journeys.

How many people work in the department?

The Specialty Pharmacy has a dedicated team of five pharmacists and six liaisons embedded within MVHS specialty and primary care offices. They deliver patient-centered, high-quality care to patients, working in coordination with providers and the rest of the care team to ensure patients receive the high-touch support they need to manage complex medication regimens.


