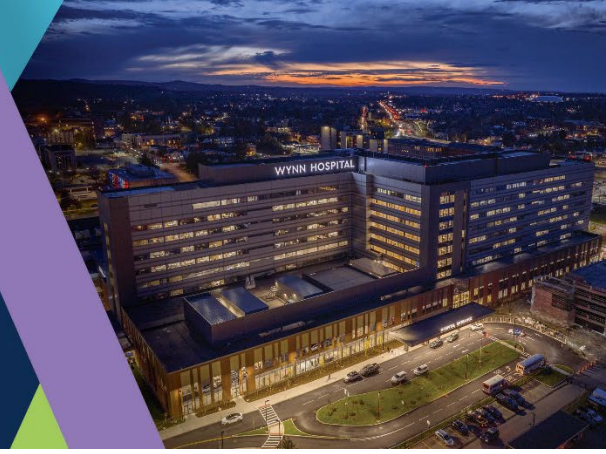

### Department Spotlight: Vituity and Hospitalists

MVHS utilizes hospitalists from Vituity for inpatient care on the Medical-Surgical floors, Intermediate Care Unit (IMCU) and Intensive Care Unit (ICU) at the Wynn Hospital. We have been working with Vituity for one full year now at the Wynn, and want to highlight the important role that Vituity and hospitalists play in our healthcare system.

#### **What is a hospitalist?**

A hospitalist is a physician who treats and cares for admitted patients in a hospital setting. During a patient's stay, they are the treating physician but will reach out to and coordinate with a patient's primary or specialty care providers regarding treatment, concerns and overall care.

Once a patient leaves the hospital, follow-up appointments are conducted with the patient's primary or specialty care provider.

Although hospitalists work on inpatient units, they can be board certified in various specialties, such as Internal Medicine or Family Practice Medicine.

#### **What is Vituity?**

- Improve patient and provider satisfaction.

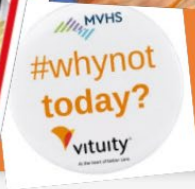
