Department Spotlight: Library Services

The MVHS librarians are your partners in practice, research and education. There are two full-time, ALA-accredited, master's-prepared medical librarians available to help all MVHS staff, including providers, residents, nurses, faculty and medical students. They enjoy working with residents and students to support their academic needs and to help them succeed academically. One librarian works at each physical location – Wynn Hospital and the College of Nursing – switching sites weekly.

Where are the libraries located?

The Medical Library is located on the second floor at the Wynn Hospital and is open 24/7. A 24/7 study space is also available in the St. Elizabeth College of Nursing Library located at 2209 Genesee Street in Utica.

What services does the library provide?

The librarians provide the following services to all MVHS-affiliated users:

- Database searching (literature searches)
- Research
- Reference
- Interlibrary loans (articles, book chapters, books)
- Training on electronic resources
- Library orientation
- Help finding information to support projects, presentations, publications, policies, procedures, current awareness, as well as assistance with mobile apps and CME, if available, for library resources.

What resources does the library provide?

Library Services provides access to thousands of e-books and full-text journals, as well as multiple nursing, biomedical and evidence-based medicine databases to use for research and study.

Visit the <u>Library Resources page</u> on MVHS computers or in Citrix by clicking the Apps tab and searching for the Library app. A collection of resources focused on the needs of our undergraduate nursing students is provided through the College's Moodle website.
